VOCATIONAL EXAMINATIONS 2023

- 1. The Vocational Examinations 2023 for prospective barristers, attorneys and notaries, conducted by the Council for Vocational Legal Education under the Law Practitioners Act 1984 will be held as from **Monday 31 July 2023**.
- 2. Registration for the above examinations will take place at the seat of the Council (6th Floor, Supreme Court Building, Edith Cavell Street, Port-Louis) from 10 00 to 14 00 hours on 2, 3 and 4 May 2023.

3. A qualified person can register for only one of the three examinations.
4. The documents to be produced when registering are as follows:
□ Birth Certificate (Original + photocopy)
□ Marriage Certificate (Original + photocopy) (if applicable)
□ National Identity card (Original + photocopy)
□ Law degree (Original + photocopy)
□ Two recent passport-size colour photographs
□ A certificate of attendance from the accredited person

- 5. A fee of Rs 10,000/-must be paid at the time of registration and the fee is not refundable.
- 6. No candidate will be allowed to register after 4 May 2023.
- 7. No candidate will be allowed to register for the vocational examinations if his/her attendance during the Law Practitioners Vocational Course (LPVC) provided by the UOM for its August 2022 batch is less than 80%.
- 8. Time tables and Index numbers will be forwarded by registered post and candidates who have not received same by <u>Monday 17 July 2023</u> should contact the Secretary forthwith.

- 9. Candidates who have obtained **Grade A** in the oral test in Advocacy at the last April 2022 Vocational Examinations and who wish to be exempted from taking the said test should submit a written application **at the time of registration**.
- 10. Prospective candidates are informed that examinations will be held under strict sanitary and hygienic conditions, as applicable.
