# Parade by United Chinese Association in Port Louis (China Town)

# on Friday 03.02.2023

In virtue of Section 181 of the Road Traffic Act, traffic arrangements as hereunder will be made on the occasion of the Parade by United Chinese Association in Port Louis (China Town)on Friday 03.02.2023 as from 1630 hrs until the ceremony is over.

### 2. Closure of road

The following Streets will be closed to vehicular traffic except in case of emergency and will be declared as a pedestrian zone :-

- (a) Royal Street from its junction with Corderie Street up to Dr Joseph Riviere Street and laterals Street;
- (b) Corderie Street from its junction with L'eoville L'homme Street up to Royal Street;
- (c) Louis Pasteur Street from its junction with Queen Street up to Royal Street;
- (d) Jummah Mosque Street from its junction with L'eoville L'homme Street up to Royal Street;
- (e) Dr Joseph Riviere Street from its junction with Queen Street up to Royal Street; and,
- (f) Jules Koenig Street/ De Plevitz/ Queen Elizabeth Ave from junction SSR Street (vehicles coming from SSR Street will be diverted towards Labourdonnais Street).

# 3. Diversion of Traffic

- (i) Buses leaving Immigration Bus Stand will use New Trunk Road to proceed to the North; and,
- (ii) Place D' Armes will be closed to vehicular traffic. Vehicles coming from John Kennedy Street proceeding to the North will be diverted on New Trunk Road. Vehicles coming from New Trunk Road will be diverted towards Caudan and Immigration Square. Traffic will be diverted when and where necessary along all the itineraries.

### 4. Prohibited Parking

Vehicles will be prohibited to park along the stretch of Royal Street from its junction with Corderie Street up to Dr Joseph Riviere Street as from 16 30 hrs on Friday 03.02.2023

### 5. Judicial Proceedings

Non compliance with these traffic arrangements will entail judicial proceedings.
