Construction of a Drain Crossing at Saint Pierre

The public is hereby informed that major construction works would be undertaken, by Transinvest Construction Ltd, in connection with a drain crossing, near the Shell Filling Station along the Moka-Camp de Masque-Flacq A7 Road at Saint Pierre.

The stretch of the Moka-Camp de Masque-Flacq A7 Road between the Vivea Roundabout and the Shell Filling Station would be fully closed to traffic on Saturday 18 March 2023, Sunday 19 March 2023 and Monday 20 March 2023, from 21 00 hours until 04 00 hours.

The following traffic diversion scheme would be implemented:

- i. traffic from Quartier Militaire on the Moka-Camp de Masque-Flacq A7 Road heading towards Moka/Reduit would be diverted onto the Saint Pierre Bypass A17 at Saint Pierre and thereafter onto the Cote D'Or B48 Road to connect to the Moka-Camp de Masque-Flacq A7 Road at Helvetia; and
- ii. traffic from Moka/Reduit on the Moka-Camp de Masque-Flacq A7 Road heading towards Saint Pierre/Quartier Militaire would be diverted onto the Cote D'Or Road at Helvetia and thereafter onto the Saint Pierre Bypass A17 to connect to the Moka-Camp de Masque-Flacq A7 Road at Saint Pierre.

To caution road users, a 'STOP-GO' traffic scheme would be operational at the construction site **as from 19 00 hours until 21 00 hours.** The road would be fully closed **as from 21 00 hours**.

The necessary traffic signs would be set up to inform and guide road users accordingly. Police would provide assistance to road users.

Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.
