

POLICE NOTICE

Chinese food & cultural festival 2023 on Saturday 27 May 2023 and Sunday 28 May 2023, along Royal Street Port Louis(China Town)

In virtue of authority conferred upon me by Section 181 of the Road Traffic Act, traffic arrangements as hereunder will be made in Port Louis North Division on Saturday 27.05.2023 as from 12.00 to 00.00 hours and Sunday 28.05.2023 as from 10.00 to 00.00 **hours** on the occasion of the ***Chinese Food & Cultural Festival 2023, along Royal Street Port Louis (China Town)***.

2. CLOSED STREET

The following roads will be closed for vehicular traffic:

- (i) Royal Street from its junction Jummah Mosque Street to junction Dr Sun Yat Sen Street.
- (ii) Dr Joseph Rivière Street from its junction Queen street to junction L'eoville L'homme Street.
- (iii) Emmanuel Anquetille street from its junction at Remy Ollier Street up to Queen Street.
- (iv) Dr Sun Yat Sen Street from its junction at Queen Street up to Remy Ollier Street(except for local inhabitants).

3. DIVERSION OF TRAFFIC

- (i) Vehicular traffic coming from along Royal Street from Government House will be diverted onto Louis Pasteur Street & Jummah Mosque Street.
- (ii) Vehicular traffic coming along Dr Joseph Rivière Street from Immigration Square will be diverted onto Queen Street except for buses.
- (iii) Vehicular traffic coming along Emmanuel Anquetil Street from the direction of SSR Street will be diverted onto Remy Ollier Street.
- (iv) Vehicular traffic coming along Dr Sun Yat Sen Street from the direction of Farquhar Street will be diverted onto Queen Street.

4. BUSES

Buses on routine trips coming from Immigration Square Bus Stand will be diverted onto Farquhar Street to NTR and to proceed to the North.

5. NO PARKING ZONE & PEDESTRIANS ONLY

Both sides of Royal Street from its junction at Dr Joseph Rivière Street up to junction Dr Sun Yat Sen Street will be declared “ **No Parking Zone** ” and will be reserved only for “**Pedestrians Only**”.

6. Judicial Proceedings

Non compliance with these traffic arrangements will entail judicial proceedings.
