Press Communiqué

<u>Traffic Diversion for Closure of the Motorway M3 at its connection with</u> Verdun Bypass

The public is hereby informed that due to major works for the construction of a flyover on the Motorway M3 at its connection with the Verdun Bypass, the Motorway M3 in both directions would be closed to traffic from 20.00hrs till 06.00hrs (night only) on **Thursday 05 October 2023**, **Friday 06 October 2023**, **Monday 16 October 2023**, **Tuesday 17 October 2023**, **Wednesday 25 October 2023** and **Thursday 26 October 2023**.

Accordingly, the traffic from the South to the North would be diverted as follows: -

- A single lane traffic scheme would be put in place on Motorway M3 Northbound after the Cote D'Or Roundabout and before the location of the construction of the new flyover.
- Vehicles would be diverted from the Northbound carriageway on to the Southbound carriageway at the location of the construction of the new flyover and thereafter join the Northbound carriageway again after the work zone.

Accordingly, the traffic from the North to the South would be diverted as follows: -

- A single lane traffic scheme would be put in place on Motorway M3 Southbound before the Saint Pierre Flyover.
- Vehicles would be diverted from Motorway M3 on to the Verdun Bypass at the connection of Motorway M3 with the Verdun Bypass where access to the South would be through Verdun Bypass through Dagotiere Roundabout and back to join Motorway M3 towards the South at the connection of Motorway M3 with the Verdun Bypass.

The necessary traffic signs would be set up to inform and guide road users accordingly. Police would provide assistance to road users.

Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.
