Interchange Construction and Improvements along M3-A14 Corridor at Ebene

Closure of Motorway M1 at Ebene for the widening of Ebene Flyover

The public is hereby informed that major road works will be carried out along Motorway M1, in the region of Ebene, for the widening of Ebene Flyover.

Accordingly, the northbound lanes of Motorway M1 would be closed to traffic as from 21 00 hours to 05 00 hours, on 15 September 2023 and from 18 September 2023 to 22 September 2023. The southbound lanes of Motorway M1 and the Slip Lane of Ebene Flyover leading to Motorway M1 would be closed to traffic as from 21 00 hours to 05 00 hours, from 25 September 2023 to 29 September 2023 and on 2 October 2023.

Works will be carried out only during weekdays and at night time.

Traffic will be diverted as follows:

- i. Traffic on Motorway M1, coming from the South, proceeding towards the North/Port Louis, will be diverted at Ebene Interchange, to proceed towards Ebene Cybercity Roundabout, make a U-turn and access the opposite carriageway to eventually join back Motorway M1, through the slip lane located at about 250m from Ebene Cybercity Roundabout.
- ii. Traffic on Motorway M1 coming from the North/Port Louis proceeding towards the South will be diverted at Ebene Interchange, to proceed towards Trianon Roundabout, make a U-turn and access the opposite carriageway to eventually join back Motorway M1, through the slip lane located at about 100m from Trianon Roundabout.

Traffic signs will be set up all along the diverted route and Police would be present to inform and guide road users accordingly. Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.
