In virtue of authority conferred upon me by Section 181 of the Road Traffic Act, traffic arrangements as hereunder will be made in Port-Louis in connection with the Fete de la Cite 2023 – Grand Prix de la Cite Moto Show on Sunday 17 September 2023

2. CLOSURE OF ROAD (as from 12 00 hours)

- a) Pope Hennessy Street from its junction with Dauphine Street and George Guibert Street;
- b) Jules Koenig Street;
- c) Intendance Street;
- d) Queen Elizabeth Avenue;
- e) Duke of Edinburg Street;
- f) SSR Street from its junction with Mgr Gonin Street up to that with Jules Koenig Street;
- g) Sir William Newton Street from its junction with Royal Street up to that with Dauphine Street;
- h) Queen Street from its junction with Bourbon Street up to that with Duke of Edinburgh Street;
- i) Ferguson Street from Place Bissoondoyal to its junction with Royal Street;
- j) Royal Street from its junction with Queen Elizabeth Street to that of Bourbon Street;
- k) Poudriere Street from its junction with Mallefille Street to that of Chaussee Street;
- 1) Leoville L'Homme Street from its junction with Bourbon Street to that of Sir William Newton Street, and;
- m)Remy Ollier Street from its junction with Intendence Street to that of Bourbon Street.

3. DIVERSION OF TRAFFIC (as from 1200 hrs)

(i) Vehicular traffic coming from the direction of Pope

Hennessy Street and proceeding towards Place D'Armes, reaching junction with Pope Hennessy Street and Dauphine Street, will be diverted onto either Dauphine Street or George Guibert Street to proceed towards their destination;

- (ii) Vehicular traffic coming from the direction of PlaineVerte along SSR Street and proceeding towards Champ de Mars will be diverted onto Mgr Gonin and D'Estaing Streets.
- (iii) Vehicular traffic coming from the direction of
 PlaineVerte along SSR Street and proceeding towards
 Place D'Armes will be diverted onto Corderie Street.
- (iv) Vehicular traffic coming from the direction of Queen Street will be diverted onto Bourbon Street
- (v) Vehicles motoring along the motorway from the North proceeding towards the City Centre will be diverted to Caudan Round About, Maupin Street and A1 road;
- (vi) Vehicles motoring along the motorway from the South will be diverted onto Louis Pasteur Street;
- (vii) Vehicles motoring along Mere Barthelemy Street, when reaching junction Mere Barthelemy Street and Poudriere Street, will have to turn right as left turn will be prohibited.
- (viii) Vehicles motoring along Reverend Lebrun Street and Celicourt Antelme Street, when reaching junction with John Kennedy Street, will turn to the left to proceed towards their destination and
- (ix) Vehicles motoring along A1 from Bell Village and proceeding towards Royal Street will be diverted either along Edith Cavell Street or Moneron Street to proceed towards their destination.

4. ROUTE BUSES

- Route buses motoring from Labourdonnais Street proceeding to PlaineVerte or Immigration Square will be diverted onto Dauphine Street and proceed to their respective destinations.
- Buses coming from the direction of PlaineVerte along SSR Street and proceeding towards Cite Vallijee will be diverted along Mgr Gonin Street / Lislet Geoffroy Street and Pope Hennessy Street.

 Buses coming from the direction of Bell Village and proceeding towards Immigration Square Bus Stand will be diverted onto Moneron, Motorway M1, Immigration Square and then to their respective bus stands.

5. NO PARKING ZONE (as from 12.00 Hours)

- (i) All closed roads;
- (ii) Dauphine Street from Pope Hennessy Street to Mgr Gonin Street;
- (iii) Mgr Gonin Street from its junction with SSR Street to Lislet Geoffroy Street.

6. **REVERSE STREET**

- (i) Dr Ferriere Street from its junction with Chaussee Street to that of John Kennedy Street, and;
- (ii) John Kennedy Street from its junction with Dr Ferriere Street to that of Edith Cavell Street.

7. JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Non compliance with these traffic arrangements will entail judicial proceedings.
