Notice under section 18(1)(a) of the United Nations (Financial Prohibitions, Arms Embargo and Travel Ban) Sanctions Act 2019

Non-renewal of Measures Imposed by Security Council Resolution 2374 (2017) concerning Mali

Notice is hereby given that the measures first set out by the Security Council in paragraphs 1 to 7 of its resolution 2374 (2017) were last renewed by the Council in its resolution 2649 (2022) for a period that ended on 31 August. As a consequence, the Secretariat has removed from the United Nations website the list of the eight individuals on the 2374 Sanctions List, as follows:

- Mahamadou Ag Rhissa (MLi.002)
- Mohamed Ousmane Ag Mohamedoune (MLi.003)

Accordingly, pursuant to section 34(1)(a) of the United Nations (Financial Prohibitions, Arms Embargo and Travel Ban) Sanctions Act 2019, the prohibitions, travel ban, and arms embargo under sections 23, 24, 35 and 36 of the Act in respect of the above entries have lapsed with immediate effect.
