(1) Post of Head, Engineering Department:

Core Qualifications:

A. Candidates should possess the Certificate of Competency as Marine Engineer Class 1 (Steam and Motor)

or

The Certificate of Competency as Marine Engineer Class 1 (Motor Only) issued in accordance with Regulation III/2 of the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers (STCW Convention).

B. Candidates should –

- (i) reckon at least two years' experience in the teaching of Marine Engineering subjects; and
- (ii) be computer literate.

(2) Post of Head, Deck Department:

Salary: Negotiable in the range of Rs 33,175 to Rs 73,800 (Mauritian rupees) monthly

Core Qualifications:

A. Candidates should possess the Certificate of Competency as Master Mariner Class I issued in accordance with Regulation II/2 of the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers (STCW Convention).

B. Candidates should –

- (i) possess good communication, managerial and interpersonal skills; and
- (ii) be computer literate.

(3) Post of Marine Training Officer:

Salary: Negotiable in the range of Rs 21,850 to Rs 54,200 (Mauritian rupees) monthly

Core Qualifications:

- A.** Candidates should possess the Certificate of Competency as Chief Mate issued in accordance with Regulation II/2 of the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers (STCW Convention).

- B.** Candidates should –
 - (i) possess good communication and interpersonal skills;
 - (ii) have training potentialities; and
 - (iii) be computer literate.
