

ENLISTMENT AS TRAINEE TRANSMISSION OFFICER

Multi Carrier (Mauritius) Ltd, a state owned enterprise having exclusive rights for Radio and Television terrestrial transmission services in the Republic of Mauritius, is inviting applications from suitably qualified candidates who wish to be considered for **enlistment as Trainee Transmission Officer** at the Multi Carrier (Mauritius) Ltd.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates should be between 21 and 35 years of age by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should possess -

- **A.** A Cambridge Higher School Certificate with Physics and Mathematics at Principal level <u>or</u> Passes in Physics and Mathematics obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education 'Advanced Level'.
- **B.** A degree in Electronic Engineering or Telecommunication Engineering or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Board.

IV. KNOWLEDGE AND COMPETENCIES

Candidates should preferably possess -

- Knowledge of broadcasting technologies and systems.
- Good command of written and spoken English and French languages.
- Ability to work at heights.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

V. CONDITIONS OF TRAINING AND ALLOWANCE

Selected candidates will be required to undergo a 12-month on-the-job training, both theoretical and practical, in all aspects of the work of a Transmission Officer.

The Trainee Transmission Officer may be called to work on a 24/7 shift system, on Sundays, Public Holidays and cyclonic days in accordance with the operational exigencies of the Company. He / She must also be willing to work on or off the Company's premises in Mauritius, Rodrigues or any of the outer islands of the Republic of Mauritius.

During the training period, the Trainee Transmission Officer will draw an allowance of Rs 25,000 a month.

On successful completion of the training which includes continuous evaluation of performance and the passing of a written work-oriented examination, the Trainee Transmission Officer will be considered for appointment to the grade of Transmission Officer*, as and when vacancies occur.

The post of Transmission Officer* carries salary in scale 27400 x 825 - 35650 x 900 - 37450 x 950 - 42200 x 1300 - 46100 x 1575 - 49250 x 1650 - 54200 x 1700 -62700 a month.

*Transmission Officer: Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. To carry out under supervision whenever necessary, the installation, operation, maintenance and repair of electronic equipment inside and outside MCML.
- To follow procedures and processes adopted by the Company to ensure smooth operation
 of transmissions including data entry on software monitoring and control platforms for
 higher efficiency.
- 3. To operate radio, television and other transmission equipment and monitor transmission services.
- 4. To climb poles, masts/towers, and other structures to restore, repair, or reconstitute antenna systems and other related mechanical systems and structures.
- 5. To survey, assemble, erect and maintain antenna supports, including tower structures, poles, guys, anchors, obstruction lighting systems and lightning protection devices.
- 6. To inspect, install, maintain and repair transmission and reception antenna systems.
- 7. To assist in the operation of software applications related to transmission systems.
- 8. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Transmission Officer.
