Notice under section 18(1)(a) of the United Nations (Financial Prohibitions, Arms Embargo and Travel Ban) Sanctions Act 2019

Amendment of One Entry on the 1718 Sanctions List concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK)

Notice is hereby given that on **15 April 2024**, the United Nations Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) **enacted the amendments**, specified with strikethrough and/or underline, in the entry below on its Sanctions List of individuals and entities:
