Micro Trenching Works in the region of Vacoas Phoenix by Emtel Ltd

Proposed “STOP/GO” traffic control scheme along various roads in the region of Vacoas-Phoenix, during day and night time

The public is hereby informed that works pertaining to the fibre network will be carried out along various roads in the region of Vacoas-Phoenix, during day and night time as detailed below:

- Phoenix - Belle Terre [Sayed Hossen Road, Phoenix - Mahebourg Road (A10), Highlands - Belle Terre Road (B68) and Belle Terre Branch Road] as from **08 August 2024 to 20 September 2024.**
- Highlands - Petit Camp (Amicale Lane, Terre Rouge-Verdun Link Road, Nestor Lane and Petit Camp Branch Road) as from **08 August 2024 to 18 October 2024.**
- Highlands - Hermitage [Highlands-Belle Terre Road (B68), Shree Shambhoonath Shivalaye Road (B71) and Lotuse Lane] as from **25 August 2024 to 15 October 2024.**

Accordingly, for safe execution of the works during this period, one lane of the above-mentioned roads will be closed to traffic, during day time **from 09 00 a.m. to 03 30 p.m.** and night time **from 07 00 p.m. to 04 00 a.m.** Traffic will be controlled by a ‘Stop/Go’ scheme under Police supervision.

Traffic signs will be set up to inform and guide road users on the approach to the works area.

Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.

The Ministry regrets for any inconvenience caused and relies on the usual collaboration and cooperation of the public.
