## **CLARIFICATION**

The Prime Minister's Office refers to the article published on 6 September 2025 in *Le Défi Plus*, entitled « *Suspension des mariages avec des étrangers: des couples dans l'attente* », and wishes to bring the following clarifications:

- 1. There has been **no suspension** of marriages between Mauritian citizens and foreign nationals. The Prime Minister's Office has issued **no directive or communiqué** to that effect. Marriages continue to be solemnized in accordance with Section 19A of the Civil Status Act, provided that all required documents are duly submitted.
- In cases where marriages could not proceed, the applicants concerned had failed to provide the necessary supporting documents, as required under Section 19A of the Civil Status Act.
- 3. The Prime Minister's Office wishes to **point out** that the statement attributed to Mr. Yusuf Sooklall is **misleading** and does not reflect the policy being implemented by the Civil Status Division.

The public is therefore advised to rely on **official sources** for accurate information and to exercise caution with regard to unverified reports.
