

POLICE NOTICE

REMEMBRANCE DAY 2021

By virtue of authority conferred upon me under Section 181 (1) (2) & (3) of the Road Traffic Act, traffic arrangements as hereunder will be made at Curepipe on the occasion of the **Remembrance Day** to be held at the War Memorial as hereunder:-

- (i) Dress Rehearsal on Friday 12th November, 2021 at 1000 hrs;
- (ii) Ceremonial Parade on Sunday 14th November, 2021 from 0900 hrs to 1200 hrs.

2. Closed Streets:-

(i) On Friday 12th November, 2021

The stretch of the road from Junction Chasteauneuf and Royal Road and Junction Malartic and Royal Road will be closed to vehicular traffic.

(ii) On Sunday 14th November, 2021

- (a) Royal Road, Curepipe from its junction with Queen Elizabeth Avenue opposite Ste Therese Church to that with Malartic Street will be closed to all vehicular traffic. Cars of guests attending the ceremony will be allowed access along Chasteauneuf Street to Winston Churchill Street; and,
- (b) Rajcoomar Gujadhur Street (*College Lane*) and Jules Koenig Street (*Ex Chancery Lane*) will be closed to all vehicular traffic.

3. Diversion of Traffic:-

(i) On Friday 12th November, 2021

- (a) Vehicle coming from the south proceeding towards Eau-Coulée along Royal Road will be diverted to Commerford Street;

- (b) Vehicle coming from Eau Coulée proceeding towards Curepipe will be diverted to Malartic and Pope Hennessy Street; and,
- (c) Vehicle coming from Les Casernes will be diverted onto Chasteauneuf Street.

(ii) **On Sunday 14th November, 2021**

- (a) Cars and lorries coming from the South, bound for the North and Vacoas will proceed along Barry Street onto Boulevard Victoria Street;
- (b) Buses leaving Jan Pallach Traffic Centre for Port Louis and Quatre Bornes will proceed along Sivananda Avenue;
- (c) Buses leaving Jan Pallach Traffic Centre for the South will proceed along Ste Therese Street;
- (d) Cars and lorries from the North, Quartier Militaire and Vacoas bound for the South will proceed via Jerningham Street, Boulevard Victoria, Ste Therese Street and Royal Road, Curepipe;
- (e) Vehicles from the Town Centre bound for the North and Vacoas will proceed via Barry Street and Boulevard Victoria Street;
- (f) Vehicles from Phoenix, Eau Coulee etc., proceeding to the ceremony will be diverted onto Pope Hennessy Street, De Sornay Street, Alfonse Raffray Street and Sir Winston Churchill Street except cars of the President, Prime Minister and Deputy Prime Minister; and
- (g) As from **1000 hrs**, vehicles coming from Botanical Garden Street, proceeding towards Curepipe Centre will be diverted to St-Clement Street and Alphonse Raffray Street. (*Dupin Street - access to resident only*).

4. **Prohibited Parking on Sunday 14th November, 2021**

- (i) Vehicles will not be permitted to park along Chasteauneuf Street, Royal Road from its junction with Q/Elizabeth Avenue up to Malartic Street, Rajcoomar Gajadhur Street (*College Lane*) and Sir Winston Churchill Street as from **0600 hrs** to **1300 hrs**;
- (ii) Access to taxi stand at Sir Winston Churchill Street will be prohibited to taxi cars as same will be reserved for the parking of cars of officials attending the ceremony. Taxi cars will instead be parked along Maigrot Street; and,
- (iii) When the ceremony is in progress from **1100 hrs**, no vehicle will be allowed to emerge onto Royal Road from Chasteauneuf Street.

5. **Judicial Proceedings**

Non compliance with these traffic arrangements will entail judicial proceedings.

The cooperation and understanding of the public would be much appreciated.
