Operations at the NLTA Counters

The public is hereby informed that the alphabetical system put in place at the NLTA counters

since May 2021, will no longer be applicable as from Wednesday, 20 October 2021.

However, sanitary protocols, as applicable shall mandatorily be observed.

Access to the premises of the NLTA at its counters (i) Flacq, (ii) the Emmanuel Anquetil Building,

(iii) Forest Side Vehicle Examination Station and (iv) its Head Office at Cassis will be granted to

any person who is either:

(i) fully vaccinated and produce evidence to that effect; or

(ii) has a valid medical certificate exempting him from vaccination and a RT-PCR test result slip,

certifying a negative result dating back to not more than 7 days from the date of the RT-PCR test

undertaken; or

(iii) in case the person does not satisfy the above two conditions, he shall produce a RT-PCR

test result slip, certifying a negative result dating back to not more than 7 days from the date of

the RT-PCR test undertaken.

The public is strongly advised to observe all sanitary measures before proceeding to the NLTA.

The usual understanding and cooperation of the public is sought.
