Restoration Activity/Hiking at Mare Sarcelle Trail (Bras D'Eau Nature Park)

The Public Officers' Welfare Council (POWC), in collaboration with the National Parks and Conservation Service (NPCS), is organising a Restoration Activity/ Hiking at Mare Sarcelle Trail (Bras D'Eau National Park) on Saturday 20th August 2022 for Public Officers and their families.

2. In view of promoting environment conservation, participants will have the opportunity to plant trees along the "Mare Sarcelle Trail". This trail was inaugurated on 22nd of May 2022 to mark the International Day for Biological Diversity as proclaimed by the United Nations under the theme "Building a shared future for all life." In addition, the park consists of an important thriving population of native plants and supports with endemic species of birds amongst which figures the "Coq des Bois" and a habitat for a variety of butterflies.

3. It is mandatory that participants be physically fit for the hiking trail. The activity is not recommended for children under 05 years. Participants are informed that the trail is rocky and comprises a certain wetland system but nevertheless is easy to follow. For swimming purpose participants can bring along their swimsuits and enjoy their free time at Bras D'Eau public beach. Kindly note that part of the Bras D'Eau public beach is proclaimed as a 'Dangerous Bathing Zone' and participants are advised not to venture within such restricted area. The Council has taken all safety measures for the day. However, participants will have to bear responsibility of any mishap caused by themselves or accompanying members of their family during the excursion.

- 4. A nominal fee of **Rs. 250** will be charged per participant, which is inclusive of lunch. The cost of participation has been kept the base minimum and is being subsidized by the POWC. As a token of courtesy, the POWC will provide free of charge to each participant bottled water (500 ml).

- 6. Please note that the buses will leave their respective pick-up points exactly at the time indicated above and will leave Bras D'Eau public beach at 15:15. Participants not availing of transport facilities provided by POWC as well as latecomers will have to make their own transport arrangements.
- 7. Public officers interested to join the excursion are requested to fill in the enclosed form at Annex 1 and submit same together with the exact amount to the POWC on the scheduled payment date. Applicants should produce a photocopy of recent pay slip/top part of pay slip indicating the name, pay site code and NIC number or any written evidence/ document attesting that the applicant is a serving public officer.
- 8. Payment will be received on a <u>"first come first served basis"</u> as from Monday 01 August 2022 as from 09:30 to 14:00 at the seat of the Public Officers' Welfare Council, Level 12, SICOM Building II, Corner Chevreau & Reverend Jean LeBrun Streets, Port-Louis.
- 9. Payment can be effected by bank card, cash or cheque to the order of "Public Officers' Welfare Council".
- 10. A cancellation fee of **Rs. 200** per participant will be charged in case of non-participation in the excursion. Please note that refund will only be considered in exceptional cases such as illness, death of close relative or any other acceptable reason, supported by documentary evidence.
- The POWC reserves the right to cancel the excursion in case of bad weather or any other unforeseen circumstances. Participants will be refunded accordingly.
