Metro Express Project (Phase 3)

Traffic Diversion for Reconfiguration of UOM Roundabout at Réduit

The public is hereby informed that major construction works in the context of the Metro Express Project would be carried out at the University of Mauritius (UOM) Roundabout at Réduit.

In view of the above works, a traffic diversion scheme would be put in place as follows:

- (i) the existing UOM roundabout would be relocated near the Post Office;
- (ii) vehicular traffic from Post Office side going to the UOM Campus would use relocated roundabout in an anticlockwise direction to cross the metro tracks at the level crossing;
- (iii) vehicular traffic from the UOM Campus going to the Post Office side would be allowed to cross the metro tracks at the level crossing and use the relocated roundabout in a clockwise direction; and
- (iv) buses coming from the Réduit Interchange and having to make a U-Turn movement to return towards the Réduit Interchange would be allowed to enter the dedicated bus lane at the relocated roundabout and use the relocated roundabout in a clockwise direction to return towards the Réduit Interchange.

The works are expected to start as from **Thursday 01 September 2022** and would last for 4 months.

In addition, Police assistance would be provided to guide road users and the necessary traffic signs would be set up for this purpose.

Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.

The Ministry regrets any inconvenience caused and relies on the usual cooperation of the public.
