Restoration of stone wall of historical value at Inner Courtyard, rear of Renganaden Seeneevassen Building, along Georges Guibert Street, Port Louis

Temporary Closure of Georges Guibert Street, Port Louis

The public is hereby informed that construction works pertaining to the restoration and repairs of the stone wall at the Inner Courtyard of Renganaden Seeneevassen Building, Port Louis would be carried out by the Ministry of National Infrastructure and Community Developmentas from **Wednesday 07 December 2022 to Friday 30 December 2022.**

Subsequently, the Georges Guibert Street from its junction with Pope Hennessy Street (as from KFC) to its junction with La Poudriere Street, Port Louis would be temporarily closed to traffic and pedestrians during the execution of works.

The necessary traffic signs would be set up and Police would be present to inform and guide road users accordingly. Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.

The Ministry regrets for any inconvenience caused and relies on the cooperation of the public.
