Extension of Delay for Renewal of Motor Vehicle Licences in Rodrigues

In the context of the Covid-19 situation in Rodrigues, the National Land Transport Authority (NLTA) informed the public that the following **exceptional** measures has been taken:

- (i) As from 31 January 2022, the NLTA cash office has been closed until further notice;
- (ii) Extension of the delay for the renewal of Motor Vehicle Licence (MVL) in respect of motor vehicle owners in Rodrigues whose licences expired at the end of January 2022. They will be exempted from the payment of surcharge provided that the MVL is renewed not later than 28 February 2022; and
- (iii) A vehicle whose fitness certificate has lapsed during the period of sanitary restrictions would be allowed to operate only in the event that the vehicle has a valid insurance cover. The vehicle owner would, however, need to proceed to the Vehicle Examination Center as soon as the cash offices in Rodrigues are operational. As regards insurance, vehicle owners would need to liaise directly with their insurance companies or agents for the renewal thereof.

The NLTA relies on the usual cooperation and understanding of the public.
