<u>Traffic Scheme for track works at junctions D'Epinay Avenue/Capucines Avenue and Draper Avenue/Glaieuls Avenue along Saint Jean Road at Quatre Bornes</u>

The public is hereby informed that major construction works in the context of the Metro Express Project will be carried out along Saint Jean Road at junctions D'Epinay Avenue/Capucines Avenue and Draper Avenue/Glaieuls Avenue as from Friday 14 January 2022.

Accordingly, the central lanes for the railway track along Saint Jean Road will be closed as from 14 January 2022 and up to 12 March 2022. Through-movement across Saint Jean Road and right turning movement will not be allowed for traffic at the above-mentioned junctions.

The following traffic diversion schemes will be set up to guide road users:

- Traffic along Draper Avenue proceeding towards La Louise/Sodnac will be required to left turn onto Saint Jean Road and then make a complete U-turn at the Roundabout to move in the direction of La Louise/Sodnac.
- Traffic along Saint Jean Road from Candos will not be allowed to right turn at junction Rosiers Avenue and Glaieuls. This traffic will be diverted onto Orchidees Avenur to join Rosiers Avenue or Glaieuls Avenue.
- Traffic along Saint Jean Road from Port Louis will not be allowed to left turn at junction Rosiers Avenue. This traffic will be diverted onto Girofliers Avenue to join Rosiers Avenue.
- Traffic along Glaieuls Avenue and Capucines Avenue proceeding towards Port Louis will be required to left turn onto Palmiers Avenue and then right turn onto Rosiers Avenue to finally right turn onto Saint Jean Road towards Port Louis.
- Traffic along D'Epinay Avenue will not be allowed to right turn towards La Louise/ Sodnac. This traffic will be diverted onto Paul Henry Avenue and Buswell Avenue to eventually right turn onto Saint Jean Road towards La Louise/Sodnac.

The necessary traffic signs will be set up to inform and guide road users.

Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.
