Closure of One Lane of D'Epinay Street from its junction with Theodore Sauzier Street up to Phoenix-Plaisance Road (A10), Curepipe

The public is hereby informed that major works in the context of the Metro Express Project will be carried out along D'Epinay Street at Curepipe from its junction with Theodore Sauzier Street up to Phoenix-Plaisance Road (A10) for a period of 3 months as from 24 January 2022.

Accordingly, the left lane of D'Epinay Street at Curepipe from its junction with Theodore Sauzier Street up to Phoenix-Plaisance Road (A10) will be closed to traffic. Traffic will be diverted onto the remaining lane.

Road users are requested to follow the traffic signs on the approach to the works area. Traffic will also be controlled by the Police during working hours.

Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.
