

Press Communiqué

Road Closure along Port-Louis – St Jean Road (A1) with its junction with Old Moka Road at Quatre Bornes

The public is hereby informed that excavation and pipe laying works would be undertaken by Sotravic Ltee along Port-Louis – St Jean Road (A1) at its junction with Old Moka Road, Quatre Bornes and the left side lane (Curepipe-bound) would be closed to traffic **as from 25 July 2022 for a period of 2 weeks.**

Accordingly, a STOP-GO traffic control arrangement would be put in place to manage vehicular traffic at the location of the excavation works during day time and appropriate signs would be fixed during dark hours.

The necessary traffic signs would be placed and Police would be present to guide road users.

Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the work area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.

The Ministry apologises for the inconvenience caused and relies on the usual collaboration and cooperation of the public.
