Metro Express Project (Phase 3)

<u>Traffic Diversion Scheme (Stage 3) - Temporary closure of Rose Hill</u> <u>Roundabout at the junction of Vandermeersch Street, A11 and</u> <u>Port Louis-St Jean Road, A1</u>

The public is hereby informed that construction works pertaining to the Metro Express Project would be carried out at Rose Hill Roundabout for a period of **9 months**, with effect from Tuesday 22 March 2022.

Accordingly, a traffic diversion scheme as follows would be implemented:

- (i) part of the Rose Hill Roundabout (near Manjoo) would be closed temporarily;
- (ii) the junction of Vandermeersch Street/Port Louis-Saint Jean Road would be converted into a staggered cross junction inclusive of a right turning lane towards the Place Margeot Bus Terminal;
- (iii) traffic along A1 Road would be required to proceed straight in the direction of Port Louis or Belle Rose; and
- (iv) traffic along Vandermeersch Street would be slightly deviated at the staggered cross junction.

The traffic signs as necessary, would be set up to inform and guide road users. Traffic would also be controlled by the Police during rush hours.

Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.

The Ministry apologises for the inconvenience caused and relies on the usual cooperation of the public.
