

Press Communiqué

Temporary Division Scheme along Sebastopol Road (B110 Road)

The public is hereby informed that infrastructural works would be carried out along Sebastopol Road (B110) **as from 28 March 2022 for a period of three months.**

Accordingly, the B110 Road would be closed to vehicles and pedestrians at the Bridge near Sir Satcam Boolell Government School. Traffic signs would be set up to inform and guide road users.

Buses of Route No. 16 from Rose-Hill travelling towards Sebastopol along B110 Road would be diverted at Lesur along Baitka Road and Petit Paquet Branch Road (Madhoo Road) to a temporary Bus Stop near the Market Fair area. The buses would then continue their journey to Central Flacq through Clavet.

Buses from Central Flacq through Bel Air and Clavet would disembark the passengers of Sebastopol at the temporary Bus Stop near the Market Fair and would then proceed to Rose Hill through Petit Paquet Branch Road (Madhoo Road) and Baitka Road.

Buses of Route No. 12 from Port Louis travelling towards Pellegrin along B110 Road would be diverted at Lesur along Baitka Road and Petit Paquet Branch Road (Madhoo Road) and would then proceed to Pellegrin. Busses from Pellegrin would be diverted through Petit Paquet Branch Road (Madhoo Road) and Baitka Road up to B110 Road at Lesur.

Drivers are strongly advised to follow the traffic signs, to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.
