

Press Communiqué

Road Closure for Road Works by the Road Development Authority at L'Esperance Village, Quartier-Militaire

The public is hereby informed that road works would be undertaken by the Road Development Authority at L'Esperance Village, Quartier-Militaire. Accordingly, the Bonne Veine Road (B51) would be closed to traffic in both directions at L'Esperance Village, Quartier-Militaire near the Kalimaye **as from 09 May 2022 to 30 June 2022**.

Consequently, the traffic would be diverted as follows:

- traffic from Moka-Camp de Masque-Flacq Road (A7) heading to L'Esperance Village would be diverted up to Quartier-Militaire and from there to proceed to L'Esperance Village through Bonne Veine Road (B51) next to the Quartier-Militaire Police Station; and
- traffic from L'Esperance Village heading to Saint-Pierre/Moka would be diverted to Quartier-Militaire through Bonne Veine Road (B51) to proceed to Saint-Pierre/Moka through Moka-Camp de Masque-Flacq Road (A7).

Traffic signs would be placed to inform and guide road users. Drivers are advised to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within prevailing speed limit.
