Construction of the Flyover at Quay D Roundabout

PARTIAL ROAD CLOSURE

The public is hereby informed that construction works in respect of the **Flyover at Quay D Roundabout, Port Louis** is on-going and is being undertaken by Transinvest Construction Ltd, on behalf of the Road Development Authority.

The Motorway M2 would be partially closed between Mer Rouge Roundabout and Quay D Roundaboutas from **Monday 07 November 2022 at 20 00 hrs to Tuesday 08 November 2022 at 05 00hrs (one night only)**, as follows:

- i. the dual carriageway to Quay D Roundabout would be closed; and
- ii. the dual (double) carriageway to Mer Rouge Roundabout would be converted temporarily to a single carriageway: vehicles would be allowed to flow in opposite direction (separated by a center line marking), on a single road.

The necessary traffic signs would be set up to inform and guide road users accordingly. Police would be located at the strategic road junctions during the temporary traffic diversion and road closure and would provide the usual assistance.

Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.

The Ministry regrets any inconvenience caused and relies on the usual understanding and cooperation of the public.
