POLICE NOTICE REMEMBRANCE DAY 2022

By virtue of Section 181 of the Road Traffic Act, traffic arrangements as hereunder will be made on Sunday 13 November 2022 from 09.00 hrs to 12.00 hrs on the occasion of Remembrance Day in front of War Memorial, Royal College, Curepipe.

2. Closed Streets

- (i) Royal Road, Curepipe from its junction with Queen Elizabeth Avenue opposite Ste Therese Church to that with Malartic Street will be closed to all vehicular traffic. Cars of guests attending the ceremony will be allowed access along Chasteauneuf Street to Winston Churchill Street; and
- (ii) Rajcoomar Gujadhur Street (*College Lane*) and Jules Koenig Street (*Ex Chancery Lane*) will be closed to all vehicular traffic.

3. Diversion of Traffic

Traffic will be diverted as follows: -

- Vehicular traffic coming from the South, bound for the North and Vacoas will be diverted onto Barry Street and Boulevard Victoria street;
- Buses leaving Jan Pallach Traffic Centre for Port Louis and Quatre Bornes will be diverted onto Sivananda Avenue;
- (iii) Buses leaving Jan Pallach Traffic Centre for the South will be diverted onto Ste Therese Street;
- (iv) Vehicular traffic coming from the North, Quartier Militaire and Vacoas bound for the South will be diverted onto Jerningham Street, Boulevard Victoria, Ste Therese Street and Royal Road, Curepipe;
- (v) Vehicular traffic coming from the Town Centre bound for the North and Vacoas will be diverted onto Barry Street and Boulevard Victoria Street.

- (vi) Vehicular traffic coming from Phoenix, Eau Coulee etc., proceeding to the ceremony will be diverted onto Pope Hennessy Str, De Sornay Str, Alfonse Raffray Str and Sir Winston Churchill Str except cars of the President, Prime Minister and Deputy Prime Minister
- (vii) As from 10.00 hrs, vehicular traffic coming from Botanical Garden Street, proceeding towards Curepipe Centre will be diverted onto St-Clement Street and Alphonse Raffray Street. (Dupin Street - access to resident only)

3. Prohibited Parking

- Vehicles will not be permitted to park along Chasteauneuf Street, Royal Road from its junction with Q. Elizabeth Avenue up to Malartic Street, Rajcoomar Gajadhur Street (College Lane) and Sir Winston Churchill Street as from 06.00 hrs to 13.00 hrs on 13.11.2022;
- (ii) Access to the taxi stand at Sir Winston Churchill Street will be prohibited to taxi cars as same will be reserved for the parking of cars of officials attending the ceremony. Taxi cars will instead be parked along Maigrot Street; and
- (iii) When the ceremony is in progress from 11.00 hrs, no vehicle will be allowed to emerge onto Royal Road from Chasteauneuf Street.

4. Judicial Proceedings

Non compliance with these traffic arrangements will entail judicial proceedings.
