Press Communiqué Construction of the Flyover at Quay D Roundabout Night Time - Partial Closure

The public is hereby informed that construction works in respect of the **Flyover at Quay D** Roundabout, Port Louis is on-going and is being undertaken by Transinvest Construction Ltd, on behalf of the Road Development Authority.

Subsequently, the Motorway M2 would be partially closed between Mer Rouge Roundabout and Quay D Roundabout on 30 November, 12 December, 13 December, 21 December and 22 December 2022 as from 20 30 hrs to 05 00 hrs the next morning, respectively.

The following traffic scheme would be implemented:

- i. the Northbound of the dual carriageway as from Quay D Roundabout towards Mer Rouge Roundabout would be temporarily closed. Traffic would be diverted onto the Southbound carriageway on a single lane contra flow for a distance of 250m; and
- ii. the dual carriageway towards Quay D Roundabout would be converted temporarily to a single carriageway to allow vehicles to flow in the opposite direction for the 250m segment.

The necessary traffic signs would be set up to inform and guide road users accordingly. Police would be posted at the strategic road junctions during the temporary traffic diversion and road closure and would provide assistance to road users.

Drivers are strongly advised to exercise caution when approaching the works area and to drive within the prevailing speed limit.
