Setting up of a Road Traffic Database in Mauritius ROADSIDE SURVEYS AT VARIOUS STATIONS ACROSS THE ISLAND

The services of the Consultants Mega Design & IDOM have been enlisted by the Ministry of Land Transport and Light Rail for the setting up of a Road Traffic Database.

The public is hereby informed that in this context, a survey is being carried out by the Consultants with the assistance of the Police.

The survey would be conducted at various stations during the months of October and November 2022 as follows:

- Saturday 29 October;
- Tuesday 01 November;
- Thursday 03 November;
- Saturday 05 November;
- Saturday 12 November; and
- Saturday 19 November.

The survey would consist of a random roadside interview of drivers in respect of the origin, destination and purpose of their journey. All data collected would be treated in <u>strict confidentiality</u> and would be used for the sole purpose of establishing a Road Traffic Database.
