4. Due to the phased resumption and a consequent limited number of staff, services will be offered as follows:

- i) Registration of births and deaths will be carried out at the above-listed Civil Status Offices;
 - ii) Couples whose Civil Marriages have already been published before the confinement period will be contacted in due course; and
 - iii) A second communiqué will be issued with regards to new publications of Civil Marriages.
5. Wearing of masks and observation of social distancing will be compulsory.
 6. Temperature checks will be carried out at the entrance and hand-sanitizers will be provided.
 7. The Public is kindly invited to collaborate with the management of the Civil Status Division.
