Communiqué

Following the second phase of resumption of economic activities effective as from 01 May 2021, the Ministry of Land Transport and Light Rail wishes to inform the public that physical distancing requirements onboard public transport vehicles would not be applicable as from 01 May 2021.

Accordingly, passengers will not be mandatorily required to observe physical distancing in public transport vehicles such as buses, taxis, contract buses and light rail vehicles. However, no standing will be allowed in public buses.

Passengers waiting at bus stops or at a bus stand within a bus station shall have to wear their face masks and keep physical distancing.

The public will still be required to strictly adhere to sanitary measures when travelling in public transport vehicles such as wearing of face masks and use of sanitisers.

The Ministry relies on the usual collaboration of the public.
