Communique issued after consultation with the Commissioner of Police

Delivery of vegetables and fruits from the 'Red Zone' (Plaine Wilhems Region)

The Ministry of Agro-Industry and Food Security wishes to inform planters from the 'Red Zone' (Plaine Wilhems Region) that henceforth delivery of vegetables and fruits to wholesalers / auctioneers will be carried out at TWO POLICE CONTROL POINTS, namely,

- (i) Parking space of Pétrin; and
- (ii) Slipway adjacent the National Wholesale Market, Wooton.

Delivery will be on **Tuesdays** and **Fridays** from **05 00hrs to 08 00hrs** with effect from Tuesday 23 March 2021.

Planters are reminded that they should be in possession of the Planters' Card at all times. Wholesalers / Auctioneers should be in possession of their Work Access Permit (WAP). Police instructions and sanitary measures should be strictly adhered to at the sites.

The delivery exercise shall be carried out under the following conditions:

1. for planters in possession of Planters' Card from RED ZONE (Plaine Wilhems Region) only;
2. for wholesalers/auctioneers in possession of WAP only;
3. Physical distancing and wearing of masks compulsory;
4. On Tuesdays and Fridays only from 5 a.m (05 00hrs) to 8 a.m (08 00hrs);
5. Strict adherence to Police instructions.
