Economic and Social Indicators

Wage Rate Index – 3rd Quarter 2019 (Base: fourth quarter 2016=100)

The wage rate index increased by 0.8% or 0.9 point to reach 113.3 in the third quarter of 2019 from 112.4 in the second quarter 2019.

2. Main changes registered in the sub-indices from second quarter 2019 to third quarter 2019 are:

Agriculture, forestry and fishing	+7.5%
Other service activities	+4.3%
Manufacturing	+2.6%
Administrative and support service activities	+2.5%
Mining and quarrying	+1.8%
Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply	+1.2%
Human health and social work activities	-0.1%

- 3. The wage rate index for the general government sector, which accounts for around 34% of the total weight of the wage rate index, remained at 105.6 in the second and third quarters of 2019.
- 4. The index for the public sector, which comprises general government and public enterprises and accounting for around 46% of the wage rate index, increased by 0.1% or 0.1 point from 109.6 in the second quarter 2019 to 109.7 in the third quarter 2019.
- 5. The index for the private sector, which accounts for around 54% of the total weight of the wage rate index, increased by 1.3% or 1.5 points from 114.8 in the second quarter 2019 to 116.3 in the third quarter 2019.
