

POLICE NOTICE
Chinese Spring Festival
Defile and Cultural Programme in Port Louis
on Thursday 23 January 2020

In virtue of Section 25 (3) of the Police Act and Section 181 of the Road Traffic Act, traffic arrangements as hereunder will be made on the occasion of the Chinese Festival on **Thursday 23 January 2020 as from 1800 hrs to 2200 hrs** in connection with the above event.

2. CLOSED STREET FROM 1800 TO 2200 HRS

All along Joseph Riviere Street from corner Royal Street up to Remy Ollier, Port Louis will be closed to vehicular traffic.

3. DIVERSION OF TRAFFIC

- (i) Vehicular traffic coming from the South along Royal Street, Port Louis will be diverted onto Louis Pasteur Street or adjoining roads;
- (ii) Northern bound buses, leaving Immigration Square will either do so via New Trunk Road or use Farquhar Street, Louis Pasteur Street, Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam Street, Sir Edgar Laurent Street and Nicolay Road; and
- (iii) Vehicular traffic may either be required to hold temporarily or diverted as required by Police with a view to ensuring the safe passage of the defile.

4. NO PARKING

Parking of vehicles will be prohibited along the stretch of Dr. Joseph Riviere Street from its junction with Royal Street up to Remy Ollier Street, Port Louis.

5. JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Non compliance with these traffic arrangements will entail judicial proceedings.
