Vacancy for Post of Automobile Electronics Technician

The Public Service Commission invites applications from suitably qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Automobile Electronics Technician in the Ministry of National Infrastructure and Community Development (National Infrastructure Division).

Salary: Rs 16,525 a month in a scale from Rs 16,525 to Rs 34,000 (22 029 066).

Core Qualifications:

Candidates should possess –

- A. a Cambridge School Certificate or Passes obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject; and
- B. the National Trade Certificate (Level 2) in Automotive Mechanics and Electronics or the National Certificate (Level 4) in Automotive Mechanics and Electronics awarded by the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development.
