COMMUNIQUE

The Ministry of Health and Wellness informs the public that the administration of a **2nd Booster Dose of COVID-19 Vaccine** will be carried out as from **Thursday 05th May 2022** for **persons aged 59 years and above** and **High-Risk Patients.** The 2nd Booster Dose can be administered 4 months after the 1st Booster Dose. It is highly recommended to get the 2nd Booster not later than 6 months after the administration of the 1st Booster Dose.

The 2nd Booster Dose will be equivalent to

- A **third dose** to those who received a booster dose following a **single dose of Janssen vaccine**.
- A fourth dose to those who received a booster dose following 2 doses of AstraZeneca/Covishield, Covaxin, Sinopharm, Sputnik V, Pfizer BioNTech or Moderna Vaccine.

The concerned high risk patients is as follows:

- Dialysis
- Organ transplant
- Cancer
- Severe respiratory diseases,
- Trisomy
- On immunosuppressants (on high dose steroids, cyclosporine, methotrexate, etc)
- People Living with HIV
- People with obesity
- People with High Blood Pressure and Ischaemic Heart Diseases
- People with Diabetes Mellitus.

The vaccine to be administered as 2nd Booster Dose will be

- o Pfizer Vaccine for
 - o High risk patients aged 40 to 59 years old and
 - o Persons aged 59 years and above
- o Moderna Vaccine for
 - o High risk patients aged 18 to 39 years old.

 \underline{NOTE} : A person who is eligible and willing to receive his 2^{nd} booster dose and who has been tested COVID-19 positive will have a waiting period of 40 days after initially being tested positive.

The programme will be carried out in alphabetical order in the following centres:

Monday and Thursday: A – F
Tuesday and Friday: G – N

Wednesday and Saturday: O - Z

All those wishing to get vaccinated are kindly requested to bring their <u>National Identity Card and</u> their <u>vaccination card</u> along with them for the administration of the 2^{nd} Booster Dose.
