Vacancy for the Post of Forest Conservation and Enforcement Officer
Ministry of Agro-Industry and Food Security

The Public Service Commission invites applications from suitably qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Forest Conservation and Enforcement Officer in the Ministry of Agro-Industry and Food Security.

Salary: Rs 14,050 a month in a scale from Rs 14,050 to Rs 30,175 (19 027 060).

Core Qualifications:

- A. Candidates should possess a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics or Principles of Accounts and Biology obtained at not more than two sittings or Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics or Principles of Accounts and Biology obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.
